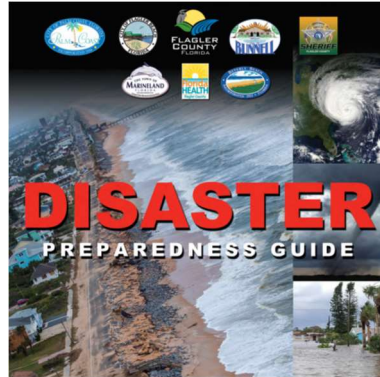


### STORMS, DAMAGE & DEBRIS
