APRIL'S HIGHLIGHT – Flagler Beach is 97 years old

Flagler Beach was incorporated on April 16, 1925. Once called Ocean City Beach, the postal authorities said the name was too long and we had to change it. Rumor has it the name was rejected due to too many communities with the same name. Residents voted in 1923 to call their community Flagler Beach. One of the early homesteaders of Ocean City Beach was George Moody who moved to the area in 1913 with his family.
