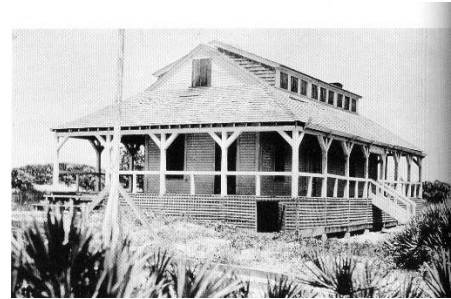
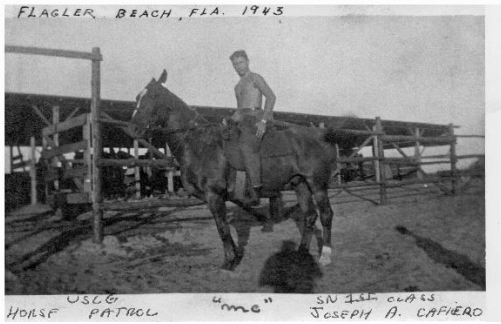

In The Spotlight

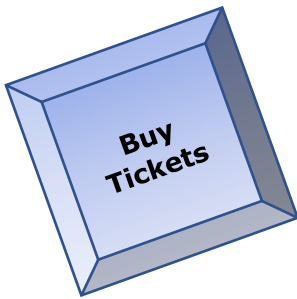
Celebrate National Coast Guard Day August 4th.
