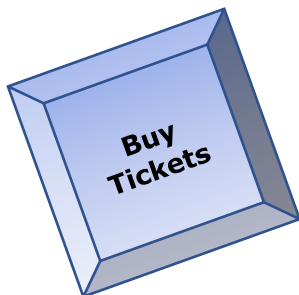
Celebrating our space program



With Artemis missions currently in the news, it is the appropriate time to showcase our Space Display featuring Mark and Scott Kelly, the only sibling and twin astronauts in the history of NASA. The Kelly brothers called Flagler Beach home as their parents Richard and Patricia Kelly were residents of Flagler Beach at the time.

The display also includes the City of Flagler Beach flag that travelled on STS-108 with astronaut Mark Kelly. The flag was taken into orbit aboard the Space Shuttle Endeavour on a flight to the International Space Station in December 2001.
